Make your own... Orange peel bird feeder!



What you need: Orange, bird seed, scissors, jute string 30cm approx, lolly stick, sharp knife, spoon.





Take your orange and cut it in half using a sharp knife. Use a spoon or a knife to remove the fleshy part and put to one side.





Cut an approximately 30cm length of string. Depending on the size of your orange.



Carefully peirce two small holes opposite eachother, approximately 0.5-1cm from the top edge.



Poke your lolly stick through like so. The will create a perch. Your feeder should look like this!

Starting from the inside, thread the string through one hole. Loop under the orange and thread through the other hole from the outside in. My Little Habital



Tie the two strings together or wait if you want to tie it to a tree branch. Add your bird seed or food of choice

Using your sharp knife, careful slit a sideways hole the width of your lolly stick. Repeat on the opposite side. These should be 90degrees away from your string holes.



Hang in a place the birds feel safe and watch for visitors.
