

# Make your own... Orange peel bird feeder!



**What you need: Orange, bird seed, scissors, jute string 30cm approx, lolly stick, sharp knife, spoon.**



**Take your orange and cut it in half using a sharp knife. Use a spoon or a knife to remove the fleshy part and put to one side.**



**Cut an approximately 30cm length of string. Depending on the size of your orange.**



**Carefully pierce two small holes opposite each other, approximately 0.5-1cm from the top edge.**



**Starting from the inside, thread the string through one hole. Loop under the orange and thread through the other hole from the outside in.**

**Using your sharp knife, careful slit a sideways hole the width of your lolly stick. Repeat on the opposite side. These should be 90degrees away from your string holes.**



**Poke your lolly stick through like so. The will create a perch. Your feeder should look like this!**



**Tie the two strings together or wait if you want to tie it to a tree branch. Add your bird seed or food of choice**



**Hang in a place the birds feel safe and watch for visitors.**
